— God Receives Your Prayer —

Psalm 6:1-10: O LORD, rebuke me not in thine anger, neither chasten me in thy hot displeasure. Have mercy upon me, O LORD; for I am weak: O LORD, heal me; for my bones are vexed. My soul is also sore vexed: but thou, O LORD, how long? Return, O LORD, deliver my soul: oh save me for thy mercies' sake. For in death there is no remembrance of thee: in the grave who shall give thee thanks? I am weary with my groaning; all the night make I my bed to swim; I water my couch with my tears. Mine eye is consumed because of grief; it waxeth old because of all mine enemies. Depart from me, all ye workers of iniquity; for the LORD hath heard the voice of my weeping. The LORD hath heard my supplication; the LORD will receive my prayer. Let all mine enemies be ashamed and sore vexed: let them return and be ashamed suddenly.

Are you at a low point in your life? It seems in this life there are many things that happen that can bring us to a low moment in our life. Did you know that God has a remedy for that low moment? That's right God can fix any problem that we have. It's very much like going to the doctor when you have a physical ailment that needs a doctor's attention. Usually the doctor asks, "What may I do to help you?" And you begin to tell him your problem and how you feel.

When you are at your lowest moment in life you can go to the Great Physician, which is Almighty God. He really wants you to come to Him with your problems. It seems from our text that David, the psalmist, was truly at a low point and sorely vexed, unable to sleep, unquenchable tears, consumed with grief and surrounded by enemies, who were the workers of iniquity. David needed help; he recognized it; he turned to the Lord; and he reveals this glowing testimony: "The LORD hath heard my supplication; the LORD will receive my prayer." So, the next time you are at that low point in your life, try taking it to the Lord. He is the Great Helper, who receives our prayers and gives help.

HBTS SEMINARY INFORMATION

At present, Heritage Baptist Theological Seminary Offers:

- * The **Certificate of Bible (COB)** for women and the **Certificate of Theology (COT)** for men: These programs of study require 18 semester course of successfully completed work.
- * The **Associate of Bible Degree (ABD)** for women and the **Associate of Theology Degree (ATD)** for men: These programs of study require 64 semester hours of successfully completed work.
- * The **Bachelor of Bible (BB)** for women and the **Bachelor of Biblical Studies (BBS)** for men: These programs of study require 128 semester hours of successfully completed work.

There are two programs of study offering a Masters Degree: The **Master of Biblical Studies (MBS)** which is a 32 semester hour program above a Bachelor's Degree, and the **Master of Divinity (MDiv)** which is a 96 semester hour program above a Bachelor's Degree.
